MODE OF SELECTION:

All eligible candidates will be called for driving Written Test (objective type multiple choices) the written test consist of three sections.

There will be no negative marking.

The candidates who qualify the above said test will be called for following Driving Skill in ratio of 1:10 of the vacancy (on the basis of merit)

Driving skill test consist of three parts: -

- (a) Dug/Ramp Test – (Reverse driving test) One chance.
- (b) "8" Shape Driving Test (for only those who qualify the dug/ramp test) one chance.
- (c) Road Test – (for only those who qualify both (a) & (b) tests above) one chance.

The skill tests will be conducted by Committee comprising of Executive Engineer, CP Divn. No.2 (Roads), General Manager, CTU & Motor Vehicle Inspector, U.T. Chandigarh. The written test will be conducted from the Institute approved by the Competent authority.

Passing of driving skill test a to c is mandatory

- The candidates shall be called for counselling before skill test and only candidates who are eligible and pass the written test shall be called for skill test.
- The passing of Heavy Transport Vehicles driving test is must for appointment of any candidate failing in driving skill test shall not be given appointment. Only one chance to pass the driving skill test shall be given.
- The final selection will be made on the basis of merit in written examination, experience and passing of Driving Skill Test and THERE WILL BE NO PERSONAL INTERVIEW. In case two or more candidates secure equal marks/ merit at last point, the candidates elder in age, will be considered for selection.
